Sports Series 2018 Proposed Rule Changes

Based on written input from competitors and from lessons learned the final of the 2018 Sports Series Rules has been prepared for your voting on whether they are implemented or not. Please read the proposed new rules. Highlighted words below are modifications to the previous draft sent out on 7 January 2018

Changes to the last rules are:

- Vehicle weight and power numbers are now as per the Porsche Club of Victoria. Previously GT Porsche magazine. Check for any impact on your vehicle.
- Open Post renamed Open A, Open Pre renamed Open B. GT renamed GT A and a new vehicle class GT B added. Classes A, B, C, D and GT A and B are for unmodified cars. Modified cars are in Open Classes A and B. Class GT cars cannot run R spec tyres.
- Clarification that kW/BHP numbers are flywheel and that there are 15% losses to wheel power for 2WD and 22.5% losses for AWD. A margin of +5% allowed on the stated powers.
- Competitors need to compete in a minimum of 3 events (including at least one Collie event) to receive an award.
- Rule regarding lower points awarded for classes with less than 3 competitors in an event deleted.
- Need to declare details of your car via pre-season registration re-introduced.
- Updated clause on minimum personal and vehicle safety. No change to 2017.
- Cancellation policy added.
- Disputes and Enforcement clauses added. This covers protests, appeals and penalties. Proposed details for who pays when there is a protest.
- New Appendix 1 which mirrors PCV.
- New Sports Series Registration Form 2018 included.
- New guidelines for dyno and weight testing.

We are trying to make the rules fair for all and would appreciate any thoughts on further ways to make the rules fairer and more equitable.
